What message was God communicating to the people of Israel?

If this is the book of Kings, why does the author focus so heavily on the prophet Elijah in the book?

Apply

In God's eyes, which of these three states of worship is more offensive? Follow God fully, reject God fully, or follow God halfway. (For scriptural grounding of your answers look at 1 Kings 18:21 or Revelation 3:14-18)

Have you ever had a "fire" moment in your life? A moment where you were in complete awe of God and were compelled to worship Him? (like in 1 Kings 18:39)

While we no longer worship gods like Baal or Ashtoreth, what are some of the American "gods" that you see? In this vein, how do we decipher what a god is in our life or culture?

With the killing of the prophets of Baal at the end of the story, we are reminded of the danger of things that can lead us astray from God. Please read Matthew 5:27-30 and discuss its ramifications in everyday life, not just the sin of adultery.
