## **Open**

Have you ever heard or been a part of something so unbelievable that it had to be more than coincidence?

## **Reflect**

Please read aloud 2 Kings 7:1-16.

Imagine you are one of the lepers for a moment. What would it have been like to try and explain what happened to someone else?

Of all the people God could have used to “scare” the Syrians away, why did he choose to use lepers?

If you were the king of Israel, would you have believed the lepers? Why or why not?

## **Apply**

As you step back and look at the bigger picture of this story, why would the writer of Kings include this in the book? What does that teach us about God’s message to his people?

God uses the unlikeliest of people to save his people. How does this demonstrate to us about how God wants to use us for his great purposes?

As we experience God’s grace in our lives it compels us to action. In what ways is God further calling you to experience and demonstrate his grace in your life?

## **Close**

As we find in the story of the unlikely victors, God provides even the midst of difficult times. For this evening, please take a moment to silently read Psalm 147. As you read it write praises or prayers to God down on a piece of paper. Use this as a special time to be with God and seek Him in the midst of where you are in your life. Please open the floor for conversation afterward so that people may share what God is speaking to them should they desire.
